Important Battery Information

1. Select language by touching the screen Touch the flag(s) to select language(s) from the list

2. Select language by voice command*

Click magic button ■, and say: Select "Language1" to "Language2"

(Language 1 and language 2 correspond the language on the left/right side of the screen respectively.)

*Magic button language recognition is according to system language you set.

Translation

Click left/right translation button to start speaking out your sentences, and wait for the translation result.

You can pause/cancel the translation by clicking these two buttons again.



Review/replay translation history

Review the translation history on the "History" page. You can also sync your translation history to your account.

Click on the translated results to replay them.



Using the eSIM

Travis can connect to mobile networks thanks to its built-in eSIM card. To activate your eSIM, simply turn on mobile data and data roaming.

Go to Settings > Network > Mobile Data.
